We encourage submission of either individual papers, full panel proposals or book symposia, on any topic in Asian and/or Comparative Philosophy. For the 2018 SACP meeting, we particularly welcome papers or panels that refer to the theme "Power and Creativity" in the context of comparative philosophy, Asian or non-western traditions. All paper and panel proposals employing crosscultural philosophical analysis will be considered.

- Feel free to submit a longer abstract (300–500 words) or to include a completed paper with your abstract in a Word file. The presentation time for each paper will be 20 minutes.
- Panel/paper proposals and abstracts (with your full name/affiliation/contact information) should be sent electronically to the Secretary of the Society, Marzenna Jakubczak, at sacp2018@gmail.com.
- Panel proposals should include the title and a brief description of the panel, as well as the names, affiliations, and email addresses of the participants. Please also provide the titles of each participant's presentation.
- Abstracts should be between 200–300 words, including a filename that begins with the presenter's last name and closes with the name of our organization and the year of the conference, e.g., "Berger SACP 2018".
- Membership of the SACP is required for final acceptance and being included in the conference schedule. Membership payment should be done via the official SACP website (PayPal Button).

- The deadline for submission is February 10, 2018. Notice of acceptance of proposals will be sent to your e-mail address by March 15, with instructions for how to register and submit the US\$ 200 conference registration fee.
